This term we continue focusing our learning of number. We will work on recognising, writing and counting and learning about the value of numbers up to 20 and beyond. Throughout the term, we will be focusing on addition and subtraction and using a range of strategies to solve number problems. We will also be looking at multiplication and division. We will be looking at character description, retelling the story, thinking of alternative endings and writing our own stories. The children will continue phonics and using their understanding of sounds to begin to write simple word and sentences.
