## Harvest Festival

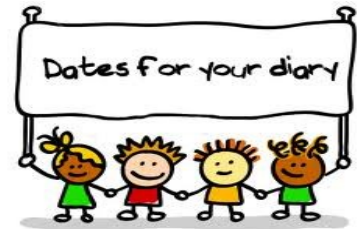
