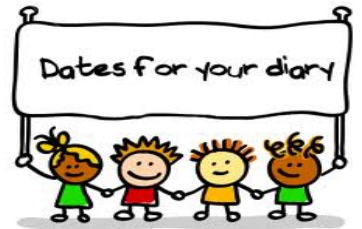
May I take this opportunity to wish you all a happy and restful half term holiday and look forward to seeing you at some of the school events after the half term.
