Our Year 3 classes visited a pantomime in Stratford. It was lovely to hear such great feedback about how well the children behaved whilst out representing our school. Well done New City!

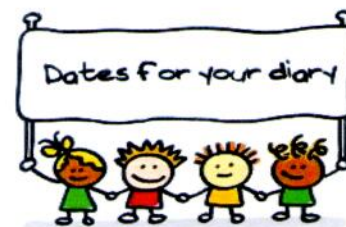
